We are pleased to welcome you as a new member of the Carefree Boat Club (CBC). Your "hassle free" days of fun on the water are now ready to begin. At this point you should have a user name and password that will allow you access to the club reservation system (ResNet). Once inside the system you can individualize this information to better meet your needs. Although you will now have access to the system, you will not be able to reserve boats until you have completed the CBC "on the water" orientation class.

New Member Orientation is mandatory and will ensure that all members:

- ✓ Can effectively navigate boats in the marina and on the open water
- ✓ Understand all boating safety guidelines and requirements
- ✓ Are comfortable with the "check out" and "check in" process when taking boats out
- ✓ Understand how the reservation process works
- ✓ Understand all member expectations
- ✓ Understand how you can ensure that you and your family maximize your usage of CBC

Immediately following this orientation you will be all set to enjoy the benefits of membership in the CBC. If you desire to utilize the "surf" boats you will be required to complete an additional orientation. This second orientation will be brief and merely focus on ensuring members can safely handle this type of a watercraft and learn how to utilize all the features of a surf boat.

All members, regardless of age, must complete all requirements to secure a NASBLA approved boater safety license. CBC will be glad to assist in directing you to the options available to secure this license. You should secure this license within 30 days of membership, and prior to requesting a reciprocal reservation.

BOATER SAFETY REQUIREMENTS

Member safety is our top priority. Therefore, all Members and Co-Members must obtain a NASBLA approved boater's license within 30 days of joining. NASBLA represents the recreational boating authorities of all 50 states and the U.S. territories. The NASBLA standards are intended to prescribe the minimum body of knowledge necessary to affect safe, legal, and enjoyable boating.

You must have been born on or before 1/1/1989 to take an online course for Tennessee. You do not have to be a resident of Tennessee to take an online course for Tennessee. You may also complete a course for a different state as long as the course is NASBLA approved.


Tennessee Wildlife Resources Agency Requirements:

If you were born on or before 1/1/1989, you may complete an online course and receive the Temporary Boater Education Certificate. Completing this Tennessee-approved course allows you to boat on other state waters that require education.

If you were born after 1/1/1989, you must take an exam administered by a representative of Tennessee Wildlife Resources Agency and cannot register for this online course. To prepare for your In-Person Exam, you may use the online Study Guide. Before taking the In-Person Exam, you must purchase a \$10.00 Type 600 boating safety exam permit. Find more information on requirements and testing locations on the TWRA website. After passing the state-required In-Person Exam, your TWRA-issued wallet Tennessee Boater Education Certificate will arrive in the mail within 8-10 business days.

ResNet Requirement:

Once you have completed your boater safety course, please email a copy of your certification to Controller@carefreeboats.com. Your certification will be uploaded into ResNet. Each member and co-member must have their own boater safety certification.





MARINA INFORMATION

BOONE LAKE ROCKINGHAM MARINA

Directions: From Johnson City take Hwy 26 Exit 17 Boones Creek. Take a right on Boones Creek Road. Go approximately 1.5 miles and take a left on Roan Street / Hwy 36 (at Zak's Furniture). Go approximately 1.5 miles and take a right on Boring Chapel Road (look for the blue CBC sign with white lettering). Go approximately one mile and take a left on Rockingham Road. The marina is about a half mile on your right.

Parking: The lower concrete parking lot provides the closest access to the docks. The upper crushed shale parking lot is also convenient if you grab the closest spot to the stairs. In the unlikely event both of these lots are full, the grass overflow parking by the boat ramp has spots. Please use the grass overflow parking if you have a trailer in tow.

Boat Location and Checkout: The Carefree boats are located on Dock 1 convenient to the fuel dock and the cafe. Dock 1 heads left/west at the end of the walkway. At Rockingham, the Carefree boats are always gassed up and ready to go. Keys are in the ignition. Please take care that you are grabbing the right boat. Be sure and complete the Checkout/Checkin process at every outing. If you have questions, call EXT 701.

Boone Lake: Rockingham Marina is centrally located on the lake. If you take a right out of the marina you will be heading upstream on the Watauga branch of the lake. In this direction, you'll come up on Jay's Boat Dock (423) 283-4060 on your right. Jay's has a great menu and serves breakfast, lunch, and dinner. The next landmark in this direction is Pickens Bridge. Take care if you are towing a tube. As you continue on you'll approach Carroll Creek Road on the lake. There is a cove off to the right that is home to Sonny's Marina & Café (423) 282-9440. Sonny's serves lunch and dinner and frequently hosts local bands. If you want to keep heading upstream on the Watauga, you'll next come to Wing Deer Park, the new DeVault Bridge, and then Hidden Cove Marina. The area past DeVault Bridge opens up and is a great place to hang out when the lake is all the way up. . . Much of this area is shallow and goes dry during the winter. This is also pretty much the end of the navigable waters for prop driven boats. If you take a left out of the marina, you will be heading downstream on the Watauga branch of the lake. The Watauga branch ends in a couple of miles – take a left to visit the dam or a right to head upstream on the South Holston branch of the lake. Heading that way you'll first note Lakeview Dock (423) 323-4665 on your left. Lakeview is open for lunch and dinner with live entertainment many nights. The South Holston branch continues for many miles up to Bluff City. You'll go through a series of switchbacks before coming to the old DeVault Bridge. Be careful on that last switchback before the bridge – if you cut between those islands, you'll likely be sorry. Very shallow. After passing under the bridge, you'll come to Boone Lake Marina (423) 391-7283. The lake continues to wind past Boone Lake Marina for a few more miles. Take a right as you pass Davis Boat Dock and you'll find some secluded boating. The TVA plans to raise Boone Lake to normal summer pool in 2021. Until this happens successfully, the above information is subject to change.

Boat Return: Always return the boats to the slip from which you departed. The Rockingham staff will fill the boat for you! Every Carefree member will have an account at Rockingham so you can charge your gas, food, and beverage purchases. Rockingham will bill you directly.



SOUTH HOLSTON LAKE LAKE VIEW DOCK

Directions: From Johnson City, take the Volunteer Parkway toward Bristol. Turn right onto TN- 394/ Highway 394. Continue to follow TN-394 E for 7.5 miles. Turn right onto US-421 S/TN-34 E/TN-34- SCENIC E, for 3 miles. Turn right onto Emmett Rd. Stay straight to go on to South Holston Dam Rd. Take the first left onto Rooty Branch Rd. Then take the first right onto Lake View Dock Rd.

Parking and Boat Location: Please park in the first parking lot you come to. At the front of the parking lot is the access ramp to the ship store. All boats reserved in ResNet are located in the slips in the boat club dock, which are the most easily accessed. You'll see the stairway up and over the water that will lead you there. The slips are marked with Carefree Boat Club and Boat Number.

Boat Checkout: At Lake View Dock, the Carefree boats are always gassed up and ready to go. Keys are in the ignition. Please be sure to complete the ResNet process both on checking out, as well as checking back in.

Points of Interest: Cliff Island is located off Point 2 and is a South Holston hot-spot. Pull your boat near the small island, swim to the low side of the island, and in 50 steps, you'll be ready for an exhilarating 10+ foot drop into the lake.

There are some great coves for water sports at the south end of the lake. East of Point 3 you'll find some great options. Much of the shoreline is brittle shale making great places to pull your pontoon boat close to shore and enjoy a picnic or some exploring.

The TVA observation building at the dam on Highway 421 is a must stop location to enjoy views and learn about the lake.

Restaurants / Snack Bars: You won't need your coat and tie to dine on South Holston Lake, but you won't want to miss the made-to-order breakfast, custom made pizzas, hoagies, and salads with fresh summer ingredients at The Wheelhouse Restaurant at Lake View Dock. Other eateries include Painter Creek Marina, Sportsmans Marina and Laurel Marina's Harbor Grille.

Boat Return: At Lake View, you are welcome to return the boat to the ship store at any time. Just grab your things and go! The staff will fill the tank and park the boat. Every Carefree Boat Club member has an account with Lake View Dock. You may charge gas, food, etc. and choose to pay at the time or be charged on the 28th of the month.

Directions: Lakeshore Marina ... only 5 miles east of Hampton, TN on Highway 321
From Boone, NC take 321 West (31 Miles)
From Banner Elk, NC take 19E to Hampton, then 321 East (30 Miles)
From Johnson City, TN take 321 East off Interstate 26 (18 Miles)
From Bristol, TN/VA take 19E to Elizabethton. Then take 321 East at Hampton (35 Miles)
From Mountain City take 67 South to 321 West (23 miles)
From Asheville, NC take 26 West to 321 East (75 Miles)

Parking: Park near the Marine Store. Our slips are on "B-Dock," the first set to the right from the store (look for the large signs at the docks).

Boat Return: If the store is open, return the boats to the gas pumps/ ship store. The Carefree Boat Club staff will fill the boat for you and return it to the slip! If it is after-hours, return the boat the slip.

Charge Accounts: Every boat club member will have an account at Lakeshore Marina to charge gas, food, and beverage purchases. Lakeshore will bill you directly each month. You are required to have a credit card on file. Forms are available through the marina business office.

Special Discounts: All boat club members receive 15% off food at the Captain's Table Restaurant. Contact staff at Captain's Table to request your discount card.

Local Things To Do:

- ✓ Eat at the Captain's Table Restaurant with beautiful lakefront views.
- ✓ Visit the many National Forrest Parks on the lake and nearby. Watauga Point is a local favorite.
- ✓ Enjoy the camping that is available throughout the area and on the lake.
- ✓ Go to Shirley's Restaurant (It's somewhat famous – live music every weekend plus great food!)
- ✓ Get hand-dipped ice cream on the lake at Cove Ridge Marina.
- ✓ Tour one the largest and cleanest mountain lakes anywhere.





MEMBER RESERVATION GUIDELINES

For assistance you may contact our staff during normal business hours via our main line at (844) 2GO-BOAT.

It is our mission to provide you with a level of service that will exceed your expectations. It is also important to realize that there will be expectations placed on our members. This will assist to ensure that the club can provide the service level, product quality, and convenient access that all members require and deserve. Please review and commit to memory the following guidelines, and if warranted penalties.

RESERVATIONS

With the ResNet system, members may make reservations 24 hrs day/7 days a week. You will receive training on how to use this system. You can also refer to our ResNet video tutorials located online under the "info" heading in ResNet or in the new member orientation materials. Please note the ResNet reservation system closes at 8 PM for the next day.

Reservations Before 8 PM Cutoff

- ✓ Are handled by member
- ✓ Can not exceed membership plan limits
- ✓ Must include starting/ending trip time as desired by member

Reservation After 8 PM Cutoff

- ✓ Referred to as "spur of the moment"
- ✓ Can only be handled by CBC staff
- ✓ Call (844)2GO-BOAT for assistance
- ✓ Based on availability

Reciprocal Reservations

- ✓ Requests handled by members via ResNet, and approved Corporate Reservationist

Waitlist

- ✓ Used if no boats are available
- ✓ Members place waitlist request via ResNet
- ✓ Utilized by CBC staff to fill open reservations

CANCELLING RESERVATIONS

Members should be aware of the importance of promptly cancelling unneeded reservations. This greatly assists with boat access for all members and can result in member fines if rules are not adhered to. As with making reservations, cancelling reservations will be handled by members via ResNet or call in.

Cancelling Outside of 48 Hours

- ✓ Completed by member via ResNet

Cancelling Inside of 48 Hours

- ✓ Member must cancel through CBC staff
- ✓ Call main line at (844) 2GO-BOAT to cancel or reply to text reminder.

PENALTY - LATE CANCEL:

A member who cancels after the 8 PM cutoff time the night before the reservation will be subject to a \$35 fine. This fee is waived the first time.

Failure to Cancel a Reservation

- ✓ Referred to as a "no show"
- ✓ Should a member not arrive at the dock for a scheduled reservation:
 - ✓ CBC Staff will wait 45 minutes from scheduled reservation time.
 - ✓ CBC staff will then try to reach member at all phone numbers listed in ResNet. Voicemails will be left.
 - ✓ If the member does not return the call within 15 minutes, and one hour has passed since the reservation start time, CBC staff will allow another member to utilize the unused reservation.

PENALTY - NOT CANCELLING A RESERVATION:

Any member who does not cancel a scheduled reservation will be fined \$35 per occurrence. This fee is waived the first time.



MEMBER BOAT USAGE GUIDELINES

Members are required to complete a float plan with each boat outing. This consists of a “check out” and “check in” process. This process must be accurately completed and signed. Most often, a CBC staff member will be on hand to assist, but in the event they are not, each member will independently complete this float plan.

Checking a Boat Out

- ✓ Complete check out portion of float plan
- ✓ Tubes and tow ropes are on hand for member usage
- ✓ Ensure all passengers 12 and under have a life jacket on
- ✓ Ensure there is one life jacket for each passenger

Checking a Boat In

- ✓ Complete check in portion of float plan
- ✓ Alert staff of any damages incurred
- ✓ Alert staff of any missing equipment
- ✓ Discard all trash

Dock Hours

- ✓ CBC dock opens at 9AM
- ✓ CBC dock closes at 8PM
- ✓ Times may vary based on time of year
- ✓ Boat usage will not be allowed during inclement weather situations

After Hours Boat Usage

Members may be allowed to utilize a boat after normal dock hours. For consideration, a request should be made with CBC staff. If not, all boats must return by dock closing. All members should understand that after the dock has closed, CBC staff will not be available for assistance until the following day. Members are responsible for the boat overnight until the dock reopens the following day. Where applicable, members will have option to enroll in lake tow membership plan for after hours assistance.

Fuel Charges

Although CBC staff assists in the refueling of boats, the marinas handle all billing and matters related to fuel costs. In general, they keep a member's credit card on file and charge this card for the fuel charges. To contact the marinas with questions on fuel, please utilize the marina contact info found within this handbook.

Boat Damage

Members are responsible for costs related to boat damage or missing equipment incurred during their outing. Members do have insurance assistance with a deductible of \$3,000 plus any hauling/towing fees. Should the member return a boat after dock hours, they will be responsible for the boat until the dock reopens the following day.

Boat Cleanliness

Each boat is cleaned, sanitized, and refueled after each outing. CBC staff completes this process and adheres to a very strict standard for how each boat is prepared and ready for member usage. We do ask our members to assist in this process by not leaving trash and other debris on board after you depart. Should the boat be returned in a condition that would require above normal cleaning to return to club standards (excessive mud, spills, trash, etc.) , CBC reserves the right to assess the member a \$35 fee for this enhanced cleaning.

Boat Driving Training

Additional training is always available for our members. From open water navigation to docking the boat, our staff is available to provide any training our members require in order to enhance their comfort on the water.



WHAT IF I...

Need to cancel a reservation?

Your reservation may be cancelled according to our cancellation policy. When cancelling outside of 48 hours, member completes cancellation via ResNet system. If cancelling inside of 48 hours, member must cancel through CBC staff by calling main line at (844) 2GO-BOAT to cancel. Any member who does not cancel a scheduled reservation will be fined \$35 per occurrence.

Am running late for a reservation?

Always be sure to contact the dock staff if you will not be arriving at the reserved time. If you do not contact the dock and you are over an hour late, your reservation will be cancelled and opened up for other members to use. Communication is key.

Am delayed returning a boat at the scheduled time?

Contact the dock to let them know about the delay. If bad weather is approaching be sure to contact them as soon as possible to get the best safety instructions. No CBC vessel may be underway after dark. If a situation occurs where night has fallen, please contact our staff to be instructed how to get home safely.

Have left an item behind?

For lost items, please contact the location staff directly. Once your item has been found, please pick it up as soon as possible.

Have a special request?

If you have a special request, such as a birthday celebration, retirement party, anniversary, etc., please contact your Membership Director and we will work to accommodate you.

Need to update my payment method?

RECIPROCITY

What is a Reciprocal Reservation?

A reciprocal reservation is a reservation at a Carefree Boat Club location to which you do not normally have access. For instance, if you are a member of the Carefree Boat Club | Tri-Cities and you request a reservation at the Carefree Boat Club | Ft. Lauderdale, that would be a reciprocal reservation.

How do I make a reciprocal reservation?

To book a reciprocal reservation, please submit a reservation request through ResNet. On your reservations page there is a section labeled "Reciprocal Reservations". There you can view pending requests as well as details for requests that have been approved. To make a new request, click the button "Request Reservation". Please be aware, new clubs which have not been open for at least six months are not available for reciprocal reservations and will not show as an option in the request form. This six month period allows the club to get fully operational and staffed before servicing members from other locations. If you have any trouble making a request, please email resnet@carefreeboats.com.

How many reciprocal reservations can I make?

Each member of Carefree Boat Club is able to use a total of three half-day reciprocal reservations per location, per calendar year. At any given time, you may only have one weekday and one weekend reciprocal reservation booked.

When can I make reciprocal reservations?

You must have been a member of your home location for at least 30 days before using a reciprocal location. Requests for reciprocal reservations must be made at least two business days prior to the date of the reservation and not more than sixty days prior.

Do my reciprocal reservations count against my reservations at my home club?

Reciprocal reservations do not count against your reservations at your home club.

Can I view my reciprocal reservations in ResNet?

You can view pending reciprocal reservation requests and approved requests on your reservations page up until the day of the reservation.

Do I need any additional training?

No additional on-the-water training is required for using a reciprocal reservation. However, because many states do require a NASBLA approved safe boating course and because we want to ensure the safety of our members, Corporate requires that all members requesting a reciprocal reservation have such a certification.

What locations are available?

The list of Carefree Boat Clubs is constantly growing and you can view all of our locations as well as a snapshot of their fleets at www.carefreeboats.com. Please be aware that new locations may not be able to accept reciprocal reservations within the first six months after opening.

GLOSSARY OF BOATING TERMS

AFT - Towards the stern (back) of the boat.

ANCHOR LOCKER - Storage space used for the anchor rode and anchor.

ANCHOR RODE - The line or chain that reaches from a ship to its anchor.

BILGE PUMP - A pump installed at the lowest inboard part of the hull to bail out water.

BIMINI - A cover used to shelter the cockpit from the sun.

BIMINI STRAP HOOK - A hook on each side of the boat, near the windshield, where the Bimini straps fasten to.

BLOWER - A switch that turns on fans so that gasses may be expelled and fresh air can circulate below – used before a boat is started and after fueling a boat (run blower for 4 mins before starting).

BOW - The front of the boat.

BRIGHTWORK - All metal, chrome, stainless steel, aluminum

COCKPIT - The open area of the boat.

CLOSED WATER SYSTEM - Its purpose is to cool the engine; typically on larger boats that are in saltwater.

DASHBOARD SYSTEM - A section of the ResNet online reservation system.

DECK PLATE - This is the fill hole for Gas, Water, and waste (for pump-out).

DEPTH FINDER - An instrument used to measure the depth of a body of water

DOCK LINES - These are the ropes you use to tie the boat up to the dock.

ENGINE HOURS - Records the total number of hours that an engine has been used.

FRESHWATER SYSTEM - Its purpose is to cool the engine; typically on smaller boats that are in freshwater.

FUEL FLOW - An instrument for monitoring, measuring, or recording the rate of flow, pressure, or discharge of a fluid through the engine.

HEAD - The bathroom.

HELM - The steering gear of a boat; the wheel or a tiller.

HULL - The shaped structure of the bottom of a boat that provides buoyancy.

INBOARD - Engine that is located and fitted at the center of a boat, inside the hull; it's connected to the propeller by a propeller shaft (most cruisers are designed with an inboard).





GLOSSARY OF BOATING TERMS



INBOARD / OUTBOARD (I/O) - The engine unit is located inside the boat and has a sternmounted prop unit; it allows for a longer swim platform on the stern, which resides over the prop.

KILL SWITCH - A red lever on a boat that is used to shut down or disable the engine in the event of an emergency – located to the right of the helm.

LANYARD - A line attached to a tool or object (i.e. attached from the driver of a boat to the kill switch – so if there's an emergency then the boat's engine will automatically turn off).

LOWER UNIT RESERVOIR (LU) - The fluid that ensures the transmission, shaft and propeller assembly of an engine is properly lubricated.

OUTBOARD - A powerboat with an engine that mounts at stern of small boat.

PORT - The left side of the boat.

PORT-A-POTTY - A plastic potty that has its own water supply.

PUMP-OUT - The bigger boats have a holding (waste) tank that holds 10 to 15 gallons of human waste. These tanks, as well as the port-apotties, require "pump outs" frequently.

SOLE - The bottom (floor) of the cockpit.

STARBOARD - The right side of the boat.

STERN - The back of the boat.

SWIM PLATFORM - A platform, usually on the transom, allowing swimmers to easily climb back onto a boat.



SWIM LADDER - A foldout ladder that extends down from the swim platform, which allows swimmers to easily climb back onto a boat.

THROTTLE - A lever used to adjust the speed of the boat/engine.

TRIM - A boat that is balanced properly so that she floats correctly on her waterline.

TRANSOM - The aft (back) side of the hull.
